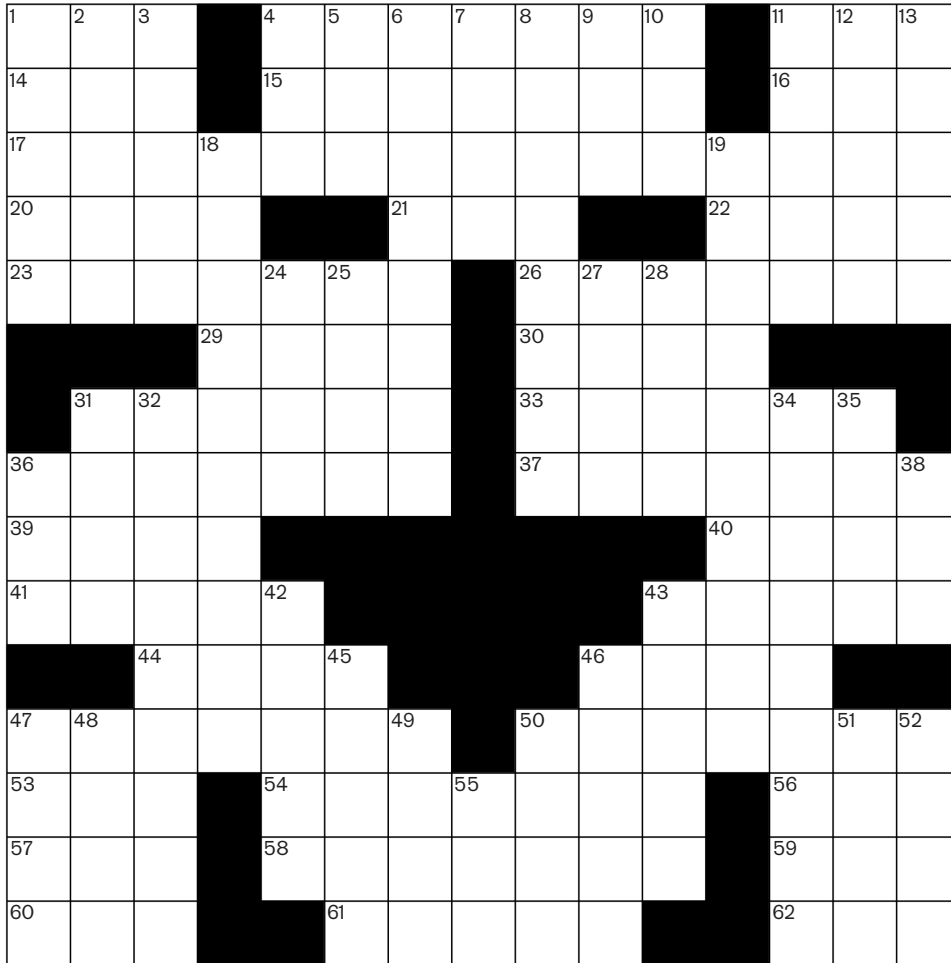


The New York War Crimes crossword puzzle
